Intersection improvement work on Kingsway, Woolooware, from Sunday, 13 May

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$300 million Urban Roads Pinch Point Program which aims to ease congestion and improve journey reliability on Sydney's key southern corridors.

Roads and Maritime Services will be carrying out improvement work which includes extending the right turn lane on the Kingsway at the intersection of Woolooware Road.

This project aims to increase the capacity of the right turn bay into Woolooware Road, improve traffic flow for cars travelling along Kingsway and reduce travel time for motorists, particularly during peak periods.

Our work activities include:

- extending the existing right turn lane eastbound on Kingsway by about 60 metres
- · removing and replacing asphalt
- lane widening and resurfacing the kerb and median
- removing the existing grass in the existing median
- new road markings.

We have included a map to show the location of work.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to six nights a week for 40 nights over a 19 week period between Sunday, 13 May, 2018 and Sunday, 16 September, 2018. Our work hours will be between 9pm and 5am from Sunday to Friday. We will not be working public holidays.

We will be working five nights a week to complete the work as quickly as possible and to minimise disruption.

How will the work affect you?

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Street parking in the work zone will be temporarily unavailable during shift hours. We will also be parking vehicles on nearby side streets before and after shifts, which will affect available street parking in this period.
