

# Intersection improvements at Narellan Road and Appin Road, Campbelltown

### Project update

#### Roads and Maritime Services | May 2018

The NSW Government is funding this proposal as part of its \$300 million Urban Roads Pinch Point Program, which aims to reduce congestion and improve travel times on Sydney's busiest corridors.

Roads and Maritime Services will be upgrading the intersection of Narellan Road and Appin Road, Campbelltown

This project aims to improve efficiency, safety and congestion on Sydney's road network.

#### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight**.

#### Our work schedule

Our next stage of works will be carried out across 60 night shifts and 65 day shifts from Thursday 14 June to Monday 3 September, excluding public holidays and weather permitting. We propose working intermittently up to five nights consecutively a week.

Day work will be carried out between **7am** and **6pm** on **weekdays** and between **7am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

Work includes relocation of utilities, vegetation removal, excavation and pavement works on the southern verge of Narellan Road.

We have included a map overleaf to show the proposed improvements.

#### Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to the speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

We are planning our future work schedule and would like to know if there are students living in the area who will be sitting the Higher School Certificate (HSC) examinations in October 2018.


