
About the charter

Current construction status

- Levee work completed
- Telecommunications relocations stage 1 completed
- Service relocations (water, sewer, drainage) continuing
- Kent Street pump station insitu concrete structure continuing
- Cross drainage culvert construction underway
- Pavement construction commenced
- Bridge approach embankments advanced.
 - Southern abutment surcharge completed
 - Northern abutment surcharge continuing
- Land Piling (Abut A, B, Piers 7, 8, Rail Viaduct) to commence shortly
- River Piling (at Piers 2,3,4,5,6) complete. Land Pier 1 complete
- Pile caps (skirts) installed.
- Marine bridge pier construction commenced (Piers 2 and 3)
- Bridge superstructure completed 7 of 176 bridge segments


General steps in upgrading a local road

- Installing barriers to protect traffic and workers
- Install signage
- Excavating
- Foundation treatment
- Backfilling with select pavement material
- Service relocations (power, water)
- Footpath relocations and kerb
- Laying asphalt and pavement




Clarence St Road Construction


Stage 2 – May to July 2018




Stage 3 – August to November 2018

Temporary Signage - South Grafton




