GRAFTON BRIDGE COMMUNITY INFORMATION SESSIONS

Two information sessions were held recently to give the community an opportunity to provide feedback on the additional crossing of the Clarence River.

An RTA spokesperson said the sessions provided a chance for the community to find out details of the latest traffic studies and preliminary options.

“The RTA project team gave an overview of the project including a new 2009 traffic study and an overview of the preliminary options on display.”

“The options are based on traffic modelling only and are subject to change pending comments from the current consultation process and further investigations,” the spokesperson said.

All suggestions will be considered as part of the next phase of the project after the current consultation period finishes on 31 March.

Issues discussed included access to the local road network, impact on properties and details on the bridge design.

Two workshops will be held to seek further feedback from the community.

The community workshops will be held on Thursday 11 March from 10am to noon and from 6.30pm to 8.30pm at the Grafton Community Centre, 59 Duke Street, Grafton.
