Thank you to the community members that participated in the telephone survey. 514 randomly selected local residents from Grafton and South Grafton and bridge users from the wider Clarence Valley provided valuable community input into this survey.

The survey was conducted between 14 and 21 March 2011 and asked residents about issues concerning the additional crossing of the Clarence River at Grafton. The survey results are now available in the Telephone survey of Clarence Valley residents report, May 2011 on the project documents page of this website.

An online business survey was also conducted between 14 April and 3 May 2011. The results of the business survey will be made available in a report in the near future. A special thanks goes to the Grafton Chamber of Commerce who assisted by distributing the survey through their database of local businesses.

The surveys form part of a wider and ongoing community consultation process and will help gauge the broader views of residents and businesses regarding an additional crossing of the Clarence River.
