

## Pacific Highway Upgrade

Turrumurra and Wahroonga - now open to traffic

December 2022

The NSW Government funded the recently completed improvements at intersections on the Pacific Highway at Fox Valley Road, Redleaf Avenue and Coonanbarra Road, to ease congestion and improve traffic flow.

The Australian Government and NSW Government have jointly funded the recently completed upgrades at the Pacific Highway and Finlay Road.

This section of the Pacific Highway upgrade is now complete, easing traffic flow for the local community and commuters. Your support is important as we continue to deliver safer and more efficient journeys throughout NSW.

### Work completed include:

- ✓ Upgrades in Curtilage Park
- ✓ Modification to service road access
- ✓ New footpaths and landscaping along Pacific Highway
- ✓ 'No Right Turn' into Coonanbarra Road to improve traffic flow
- ✓ Kerb realignment and new raised median to improve turn paths
- ✓ 'No Right Turn' out of Marshall Avenue and Finlay Road to improve traffic safety
- ✓ Road widening to provide three continuous northbound lanes on Pacific Highway while maintaining dedicated turning lanes at Fox Valley Road and Redleaf Avenue
- ✓ A new signalised intersection at Redleaf Avenue to provide a safe right turn access from Pacific Highway to the Wahroonga Shopping Village, train station and residential properties in the area.

## Finishing work

We still need to do some minor work at night including concreting, property adjustments and landscaping.

Work will be carried out during day and night shifts, weather permitting. Our night work hours are **8pm** and until **5am** the next day, up to **five nights per week** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. We will not work during the day on Sundays, public holidays or during heavy rainfall. This final work is not expected to generate loud noise. Traffic will not be affected during the day.

We are expecting to complete finishing work in **early 2023**.

We won't be carrying out any work over the **Christmas period** from **Thursday 22 December 2022** until **Monday 9 January 2023**. The project team will be recommencing work from Monday 9 January 2023. Customers may continue to see construction staff on site throughout this period only for safety inspections.

## Project benefits

These now complete improvement works will ease congestion for the high numbers of vehicles using this section of the Pacific Highway at Redleaf Avenue, Coonanbarra Road and Fox Valley Road, by providing additional northbound lanes on the Pacific Highway.
