Update - Temporary footpath closure

Transport for NSW is delivering improvements to intersections on the Pacific Highway at Redleaf Avenue, Coonanbarra Road and Fox Valley Road, to ease congestion and improve traffic flow.

Footpath closure extended

The footpath on the western side of Pacific Highway between Fox Valley Road and Gilda Avenue is **currently temporarily closed**. Previously we advised that the footpath would reopen end of March, however due to inclement weather, we need the footpath closed **until June 2022.**

How will the closure affect you?

The pedestrian detour will remain in place on Pacific Highway and include safe pedestrian crossings at Ada Avenue and at Knox Grammar School. For your safety, please follow the detour route outlined in the map and the direction of the signs. Access to properties will be maintained.

Curtilage Park will remain closed to the community until July.

Our work schedule

Our day work hours will remain from 7am to 6pm on Mondays to Fridays, and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm. Our night work hours from Sunday to Thursday are from 8pm to 5am the next day. We will work up to five nights per week.

Where possible, we will work during the day, however, to reduce impacts to the local traffic network and to ensure the safety of our workers some work is required at night. The work may be noisy at times however we will stop noisier activities such as using concrete saw or chainsaw, prior to midnight.
