
Investigation work at 100-102 Fox Valley Road, Wahroonga from 22 August

Transport for NSW is preparing the former site compound at 100-102 Fox Valley Road, Wahroonga for future sale. We closed the site compound for project related operations on Wednesday 30 June 2021. As we prepare the site for future sale, we need to investigate the site for asbestos.

What's happening?

We will be doing some minor excavation on the site and we will be sending the excavated material to test for asbestos. Any asbestos containing material found on site will be managed in accordance with our Asbestos Management Plan, and strict Environmental Protection Authority requirements.

Our work schedule

We will be on site from Monday 22 August, weather permitting.

We will be working for up to **ten day shifts**. Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday**.

We will not work on public holidays or during heavy rainfall. If the work is cancelled due to rain, we will complete the work at the next available shift.

What you may notice

Whilst undertaking this important work we will be following strict safety precautions to ensure the safety of our workers and the local community. To ensure the safety of workers and the community, we will be isolating the work area with safety fences and asbestos warning signs will be placed at the entrance to the site. Workers will wear protective suits when carrying out asbestos investigation and removal works.

Ongoing asbestos monitoring

Further asbestos may be discovered as we work on the restoration of the site compound. If additional asbestos is discovered and further work is required, we will let you know.
