Pacific Highway Upgrade

Turramurra to Wahroonga

Road pavement works - November 2022

The NSW Government is funding improvements at intersections on the Pacific Highway at Redleaf Avenue, Coonanbarra Road and Fox Valley Road to ease congestion and improve traffic flow.

Night work

We are carrying out work at night to lay new asphalt on the road, which will involve milling and re-sheeting.

As the work is taking place at intersections along the Pacific Highway, unfortunately we will be starting work later than usual at night.

The work will take place at **two locations** across **11 nights** from **Sunday 30 October to Sunday 20 November**, weather and site conditions permitting. (see map attached).

At our northern work site, we will be working the first 5-6 nights, between 30 October and 13 November, on Pacific Highway between Redleaf Avenue to Munderah Avenue.

At our southern worksite we will be working the second 5-6 nights, between 06 November to 20 November, on Pacific Highway between Gilda Avenue to Marshall Avenue.

Due to varying weather and site conditions, we require flexibility to finalise this work and appreciate your patience. We will not work more than five consecutive nights in one week without a two-day break.

How will the work affect you?

To ensure safety of road users we will be starting some of the night works later than usual, from 11pm and ending at 5am.

Our high noise activities involve jackhammering and concrete saw cutting.

Usually, these high noise activities would be completed before midnight, however due to the late commencement of works, these high noise activities will instead be completed before **2am.**

We will employ noise curtains for the high noise activities to minimise impacts. We will direct any lighting away from residential properties and turn off machinery when not in use.

Once these 11 shifts have been completed, high noise activities will return to being completed by midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures and detours in place for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists while we are working to ensure the work area is safe for road users and our workers. Clearly marked pedestrian detours will be provided.


