

# Transport Access Program Blacktown Station Upgrade

# **COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION**

# OCTOBER 2017

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure. The Blacktown Station Upgrade includes:

- a new pedestrian footbridge connecting the Richmond Line concourse with the main concourse
- a new lift and stairs connecting Platform 3 with the new footbridge
- new stairs and weather protection canopies to platforms 1 and 2.

## **Upcoming construction activites**

Over the coming months, you may notice the following activities on site:

- finalising the installation of structural steel, roof sheeting and gutters to the new footbridge
- excavation and installation of drainage
- upgrading of curbs and gutters within the bus terminal
- form work for traffic barriers within the bus terminal
- installation of mesh screens on platforms 1 and 2
- installation of cable trays and electrical services
- fit out for the lifts on platforms 1/2 and 3
- concreting activities.

### Night works – October to early November 2017

To minimise disruption to passengers, some work activities will be undertaken at night including the installation of structural steel, roof sheeting and gutters to the new footbridge and upgrades to curbs and gutters within the bus terminal. These activities will be carried out over four nights between **6pm to 7am** on the following nights:

- Monday 9 October to Thursday 12 October 2017
- Monday 16 October to Thursday 19 October 2017
- Monday 23 October to Thursday 26 October 2017
- Monday 30 October to Thursday 2 November 2017.

These activities have been planned to minimise noise and limit the impact on local residents.

The **George Street T-way** leading to the roundabout will be **CLOSED** to buses on the following nights between **8pm to 5am**:

- Monday 16 October to Thursday 19 October 2017
- Monday 23 October to Thursday 26 October 2017.

Diversion routes will be in place and buses will access the Blacktown bus interchange via Third Avenue. The following changes to bus services will be in effect:

- Stand L bus services 611 and 630 will be relocated to Stand H
- Stand K bus services 705 and 711 will be relocated to Stand H
- CDC Hillsbus services 705 and 711 will be temporarily suspended from Devitt and Sackville T-way bus stops. To access services 705 and 711, please use the bus stop at Sackville Street before Peter Street.

Signage will be been installed to notify users of these changes.

#### What equipment will be used?

The following equipment will be used during construction:

• power and hand tools	• cranes	generators
elevated work platforms	semi-trailers	construction vehicles
excavators	traffic control vehicles	• oxy kits
• grinders	concrete truck and pump	• jackhammers
rattle guns	light towers	<ul> <li>road saws</li> </ul>
concrete trucks	• forklifts	• vacuum trucks

Some of the works may be noisy. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to commuters, nearby residents and businesses. Where required, traffic controllers will be on site to facilitate safe pedestrian and vehicle movements.

### **Construction hours**

All other work will continue to be carried out during standard constructions hours which are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.** The community will be notified of any works outside these hours prior to the works commencing.
